

SAN FANTINO ROSSO Red wine

Variety: Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah, others.

Year: 2013

Production: 1000 bottles

Price: 50 Euro for a 6 bottle case



San Fantino Rosso comes from the San Fantino estate, 5 hectares of sowing fields, orchards, woodland and about 5,000 sqm of vineyard. The estate is 450m above sea level.

Most of the vines are about 20 years old Merlot, Syrah and Cabernet Sauvignon; there are also a few much older vines of various varieties including Aglianico, Pink and White Muscat, Sangiovese and some unknown ones.

Biodynamic and organic principles are followed. Everything is done by hand or by foot...

Harvest is usually at the beginning of October when sugar content reaches 20-21 degrees Babol leading to a 12.5-13° of alcohol. Only the best grapes are selected for this wine.

Sulfites are added for preservation in the measure of 2-3 gr per 100 litres.

Tasting notes:

Colour: garnet.

Nose: red fruit (cherry above all), pepper, liquorice, tobacco, flowers (elderflower); persistent.

Mouth: soft, rather warm with good body but not heavy; soft and smooth tannins; ripe red fruit, pink pepper and elderflower; long.

An aristocratic wine, soft and easy to drink, very good with red meat, game and mushrooms
